There are some other good features as well - including gyro motion as well as a ton of configurations if you want to tweak up your controller to the max.

Serious Rocket League players have the Steam Controller grips programmed for acceleration/brake and triggers for drift/boost. Cities Skylines has moved into the living room for many people.
