"For the Scythe NCU-2000 to work properly inside the PC, the fins of the heatsink have to be oriented vertically. If the fins are oriented horizontally, convection cooling won't be nearly as effective because as the hot air rises, it will not be passing through the heatsink fins. How the NCU-2000 actually stays cool without a fan is what will discuss next ."
